- While under consideration entries may not be submitted for publication elsewhere until the publishers have confirmed in writing that the manuscript has been turned down for publication.
- The judges reserve the right to withhold one or more of the prizes should the quality of the en-tries not be up to standard.
- 7. The competition is open only to citizens of South Africa, Namibia, Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland.
- 8. Entries should be typed or printed out on A4 paper or submitted by email to the address under (15) below. In both cases, documents should be set up with

broad margins and with pages clearly numbered. Do not bind. As entries are judged anonymously, writers are requested to ensure that their names appear only on the


nowhere else.
